Dress Code

Golf attire is part of the Game's tradition. Over the years, golf wear has evolved to a sportier look designed for performance. All members and guests must be appropriately dressed while on Club premises. This applies to all areas—the course, Pro Shop, Clubhouse and practice areas. Members are required to inform guests and family of the Club's dress code. Please avoid embarrassment for guests and staff who must inform them their attire is unacceptable.

Management is empowered to enforce the dress code and to make discretionary decisions where necessary.

Honouring tradition, comfort and fashion, Willow Park has adopted the Dress Code guidelines below:

<u>Dress Regulations</u>: The Board of Directors and Management trust that Members and their Guests will choose to dress in a manner suitable to the extraordinary surroundings and services provided at Willow Park.

Appropriate golf apparel is required on the golf course. In the Clubhouse upscale casual attire, including dressed-up denim, is also suitable. Etiquette applies. As an example, gentlemen are asked to remove their hats in the Clubhouse.

Members and Guests dressed inappropriately in the opinion of Management or their designate can expect to be asked to adjust their attire or depart the property.

Golf shoes: Members and Guests are required to wear soft spikes. No metal spikes are permitted.

Please note:

- On the Course, golf sportswear is considered minimum attire.
- Denim material of any type or colour (must be respectable denim, non-frayed, no holes, no low rise) is permitted in the Clubhouse but not on the golf course except during Stampede week.
- Clothing or equipment may not display objectionable or offensive language, excessive writing and non-golf related insignias or prominent logos.
- Members sponsoring guests or functions for family or friends, are required to inform them of the Club's dress code. Please avoid embarrassment for the guest and staff who must inform them their attire is unacceptable.
- Management is empowered to enforce the above code and to make discretionary decisions where necessary.

Electronics

Willow Park Golf & Country Club is first and foremost a place to come and enjoy friends and escape worldly concerns. To that end, please be mindful that when using your cell phone on the golf course or in the Clubhouse, you may be interrupting the experience others are enjoying.

Policy

- Set any cell phone carried onto the Course or in the Clubhouse to vibrate or silent.
- If making or receiving a call is necessary, please be discreet. Leave the patio, lounge or dining room, enabling members to enjoy the experience for which they came. On the golf course, ensure not to distract your playing partners and other golfers in the vicinity. If your conversation impacts the speed of play, please pick up your ball.
- Use of headphones for safety reasons are not permitted while on the course.
- When playing music electronically on the course, please keep the volume at a respectable level as not to distract or interrupt other golfers/groups.
- Members are to ensure their guests are aware of and follow this policy.
