Tee Time Booking Information

Willow Park uses a 7-day advance ballot system for tee time bookings every day of the week.

- Tee times can be booked on-line through the website, by phone or in person.
- Reserving online is the most effective way to book.
- The automated system will generate a daily draw four days in advance.
- All ballot requests must be submitted by 6 pm the day before the specified draw generation day.
- After the draw is published, any non-balloted times can be booked online or by phoning the Pro Shop.
- Tee times are booked based on player classification.
- Tee time draws will be generated and posted by 11 am on the specified day:

Monday's generated by Thursday. Ballot closes Wednesday at 6 pm.

Tuesday League Day - NO Ballot.

Wednesday's generated by Saturday. Ballot closes Friday at 6 pm.

Thursday's generated by Sunday. Ballot closes Saturday at 6 pm.

Friday's generated by Monday. Ballot closes Sunday at 6 pm.

Saturday's generated by Tuesday. Ballot closes Monday at 6 pm.

Sunday's generated by Wednesday. Ballot closes Tuesday at 6 pm.

- Pro Shop is located in a separate building a short walk south of the Clubhouse.

Events and Programs
